What's a Town Hall meeting? On Sunday November 16 we're having a Town Hall meeting after worship that includes a potluck lunch. I hope you can attend. A town hall meeting for our church is an opportunity to sit down with our elders and learn about the direction they're discerning for our church.

I want to remind you that a Presbyterian church is a church governed by volunteer "ruling elders" elected by the congregation for that purpose. We are not "pastor run." In contrast I as your pastor am called a "teaching elder" and my role is to teach God's Word in such a way that it equips you to make disciples and thus do the work of the ministry.

Our ruling elders presently meet once a month to pray, study and discern God's direction for our church. This summer we spent a Saturday morning together and an extra evening considering some options for the future of our church. While there are many things we like about our church the way it is now, we know it can't go on like this indefinitely. Our size and age will see to that. Besides there is a vast population outside our church walls who are not hearing the good news of Jesus Christ through our present programs. We know God has called us to proclaim his good news and make disciples of those who follow him. So changes

must and will be made.

Come to the Town Hall meeting on November 16 and learn the direction we believe the Holy Spirit is leading us. Come with your questions and a generous, open mind. Our Session values your input. Let's have some family time and come together as a family to discuss our future. I look forward to seeing you.

(You may bring wrapping paper separately if you like)








Wayne and Sue made a difference.

### MISSIONS – THE HEART OF THE CHURCH

### **Understanding Faith Promise Giving**

Faith Promise Giving is more than just a method of raising money for Missions. It is a Faith Commitment and Faith is central to the Christian life. As Stewardship approaches and IPC considers its budget for its ministries in the upcoming year, please prayerfully consider your Faith Promise for Missions:

### **How to Make a Faith Promise for Missions**

- 1. Pray for God's direction to discern the amount of the commitment. Pray also for God's enabling help to fulfill that commitment.
- 2. Make a realistic assessment of your situation. This is not a contradiction. E.g. If you have just entered the workforce and have thousands of dollars of student loans, it isn't realistic to make a Faith Promise of \$10,000. Though a Faith Promise can be fulfilled in unexpected and miraculous ways, that isn't the norm.
- 3. If God is strongly directing you to make a Faith Promise that seems unrealistic, make it and trust that God will enable you to fulfill it.
- 4. Obey God's voice.
- 5. Trust God completely that he will enable you to give more than you think you can give and at the same time meet all your personal needs.
- 6. Be faithful to give as God enables you.
- 7. When Stewardship asks for your General Giving Pledge, also provide your Faith Promise amount for Missions.
- 8. Each week mark your Giving Envelope with the amount you are giving for "Missions".

Remember, a Faith Promise is between an individual and God. The commitment is "As God enables me I will be faithful to give". You will not be called on the amount if you cannot meet it.
