Dear Friends,

In just a short while the season of Lent will be underway. Lent is a 40 day period of time for us to reflect on who we are in relation to God. Yes, we are aware that we're sinners in need of a savior but what does that really mean? We don't act like terrorists. Sometimes we're a little rude on the freeway but hey we're not too bad. So why do we need a savior if we can do it ourselves? That's why we need Lent.

We're kicking off Lent with an **Ash Wednesday service on Feb. 10 at 7:00 pm.** The idea "Dust to dust, ashes to ashes" is based on Genesis 3:19, Genesis 18:27, Job 30:19, and Ecclesiastes 3:20 which says that we came from dust and to dust we will return. It's kind of humbling that of all our self-made importance we come down to a pile of dust. Ash Wednesday helps us put things in perspective as we start off the season of reflection.

Then on Valentine's Day, Sunday February 14 we kick off a new sermon series specifically for Lent called "The Jesus Creed". When Jesus had to summarize all his teaching he summed it up using an ancient Jewish creed called the "shema". Jesus said to "love the Lord your God with all your heart, soul, mind and strength and your neighbor as yourself." For six weeks we're going to talk about that creed, memorize it and practice evaluating our lives in relations to it.

For the six weeks of Lent starting the week of Valentine's Day I'm going to be offering unique small groups called "Jesus Creed Groups" that will meet once a week for worship, prayer, teaching and reflection on the Jesus Creed. They will conclude the week before Easter. Together in small groups we will learn and

practicing applying this great creed to our lives. There will be groups meeting during the day and evening to accommodate everyone's schedule.

What will you do for Lent? I hope you'll attend the **Ash Wednesday service on February 10** and join a **six week Jesus Creed group**. Have you ever wondered what kind of training goes with God's call to full time service? For the Navigator Organization it is very detailed Biblical study and Scripture memory and each of their workers is skilled in teaching individuals how to study and learn and how to apply the lessons in their own lives. This form of study and learning is called discipling or discipleship. It is the basic method used by the Navigators and was instigated and perfected by the founder of the organization, Dawson Trotman back in the late 1930's at the beginning of World War II.

Jack and Joanne Blanch, a couple you help to support with your Mission dollars, both have now and have had for many years, individuals they have discipled who now are actively passing on these skills to others so that the workers for Christ increase exponentially.




