SERMON NOTES:

“I have seen the Lord”

The different “seeing” in John 20:1-18

1. _____.

John 20:1 (NIV) Early on the first day of the week, while it was still dark, Mary Magdalene went to the tomb and **saw** that the stone had been removed from the entrance.

John 20:4–7 (NIV) ⁵ He bent over and **looked** in at the strips of linen lying there but did not go in. ⁶ Then Simon Peter came along behind him and went straight into the tomb. He **saw** the strips of linen lying there, ⁷ as well as the cloth that had been wrapped around Jesus’ head. The cloth was still lying in its place, separate from the linen.

2. _____.

John 20:8 (NIV) Finally the other disciple, who had reached the tomb first, also went inside. He **saw and believed**.

3. _____.

John 20:11-12 (NIV) Now Mary stood outside the tomb crying. As she wept, she bent over **to look** into the tomb and **saw** two angels in white, seated where Jesus’ body had been, one at the head and the other at the foot.

4. _____.

John 20:18 (NIV) Mary Magdalene went to the disciples with the news: **“I have seen the Lord!”** And she told them that he had said these things to her.

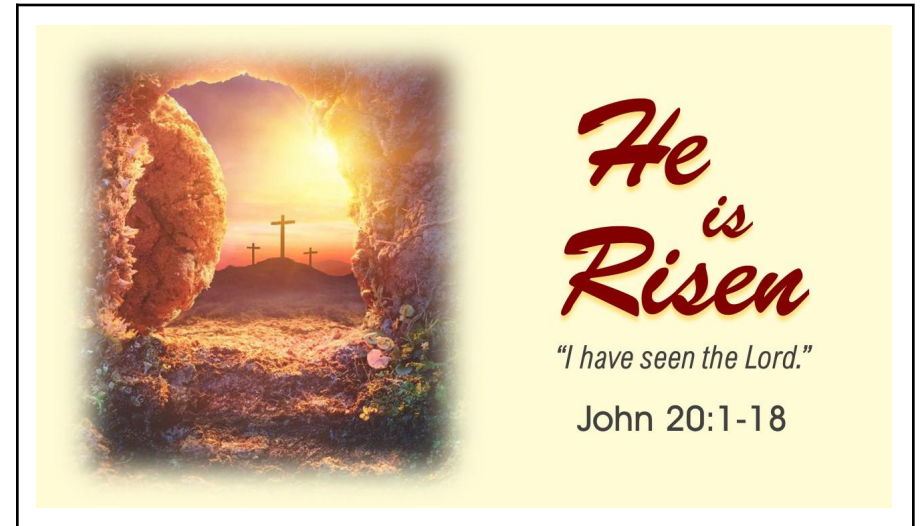
