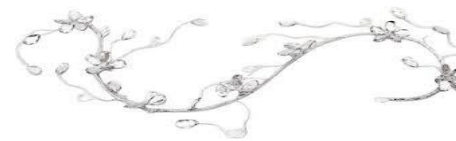

SERMON NOTES: The Call of Samuel

1 Samuel 3:1-10, 19-21; 2 Corinthians 4:5-12; Mark 2:23-3:6

What happens when God calls you?

1. God calls you _____.

1 Samuel 3:1, 3, 20 (NIV) The boy Samuel ministered before the LORD under Eli. In those days the word of the LORD was rare; there were not many visions. The lamp of God had not yet gone out, and Samuel was lying down in the house of the LORD, where the ark of God was. And all Israel from Dan to Beersheba recognized that Samuel was attested as a prophet of the LORD.

2 Corinthians 4:6 (NIV) For God, who said, "Let light shine out of darkness," made his light shine in our hearts to give us the light of the knowledge of God's glory displayed in the face of Christ.

2. God calls you _____.

2 Corinthians 4:7-12 (NIV) But we have this treasure in jars of clay to show that this all-surpassing power is from God and not from us. ⁸ We are hard pressed on every side, but not crushed; perplexed, but not in despair; ⁹ persecuted, but not abandoned; struck down, but not destroyed. ¹⁰ We always carry around in our body the death of Jesus, so that the life of Jesus may also be revealed in our body. ¹¹ For we who are alive are always being given over to death for Jesus' sake, so that his life may also be revealed in our mortal body. ¹² So then, death is at work in us, but life is at work in you.

Mark 2:28 (NIV) So the Son of Man is Lord even of the Sabbath."

2 Corinthians 12:9 (NIV) But he said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness." Therefore I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ's power may rest on
