2 Samuel 5:10 And he became more and more powerful, because the Lord God Almighty was with him.

2. _____ is better than spiritual ecstasy.

2 Corinthians 12:2, 7-9 I know a man in Christ who fourteen years ago was caught up to the third heaven. Whether it was in the body or out of the body I do not know—God knows.
