What is to be filled and be full?

### 1. It means

1. It means 2 Kings 2:10-12<sup>10</sup> Then David rested with his ancestors and was buried in the City of David. <sup>11</sup> He had reigned forty years over Israel—seven years in Hebron and thirty-three in Jerusalem. <sup>12</sup> So Solomon sat on the throne of his father David, and his rule was firmly established.
