Psalm 40; Isaiah 49:1-7; 1 Corinthians 1:1-9; John 1:29-42

1. God called _____.

Isaiah 49:1, 5, 6

Before I was born the Lord called me; from my mother's womb he has spoken my name.

And now the Lord says— he who formed me in the womb to be his servant to bring Jacob back to him and gather Israel to himself, for I am honored in the eyes of the Lord

“It is too small a thing for you to be my servant to restore the tribes of Jacob and bring back those of Israel I have kept. I will also make you a light for the Gentiles, that my salvation may reach to the ends of the earth.”

2. God called us _____.

1 Corinthians 1:7-9

Therefore you do not lack any spiritual gift as you eagerly wait for our Lord Jesus Christ to be revealed.
